DIFFERENCE MAKERS AT MJHS



Mrs. Stephanie Dunn's Current Events class took a short break from politics and the news to focus on current issues in our school building. After the assembly with Joe Beckman, students decided that they wanted to be Difference Makers, so the students formed groups, identified a need, and developed a plan to meet that need. Here is a brief description of each project:

Group 1 – Students purchased enough suckers for each student at the JH. Then, they printed paper strips to attach to each sucker that say, "I love your face," a Joe Beckman quote. They are passing them out to each student during Jaytime on December 6th.

Group 2 – Students created a Kindness Calendar. The calendar suggests a different kind act to complete each day of the week. When students complete the kind act, they sign their names on the calendar to see how the kindness is spreading. The focus week is December 3rd-December 6th.

Group 3 – Students are going to "Keep the Kindness Going" by following the kindness calendar week with "Caught Being Kind" vouchers. They will provide each teacher with vouchers, stickers, and suckers. The teachers will hand out the voucher and a sticker or sucker to students they catch doing kind acts.

Group 4 – Students are creating a PSA video to be shown on a future Jaycast. In the video, they promote how to be a difference maker, rather than a difference taker.

Group 5 – Students are hosting a clothing drive with an opportunity for the community to "shop" for gently used and new clothing donated by students at MJHS. The pop-up shop will be open in the JH Cafeteria from 5:00-7:30 pm on December 16th.
